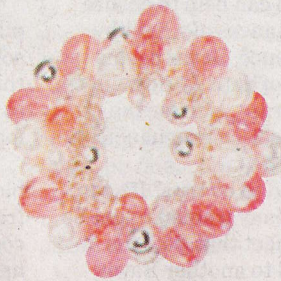


Trio of products support breast cancer research

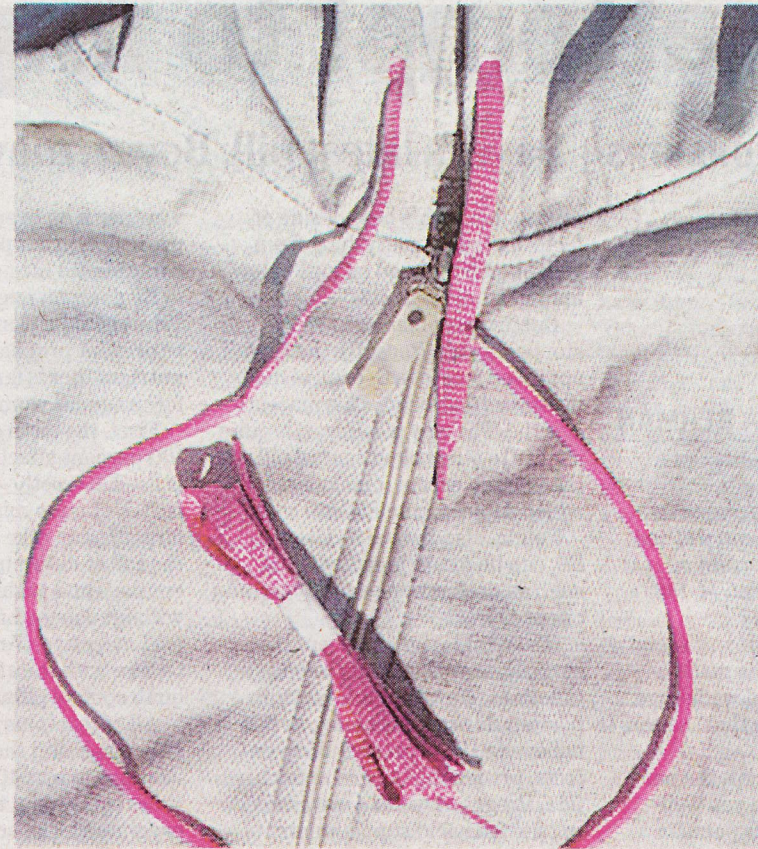


Bauble Bracelet by Chico's
